

The Parliamentary Crown of New Zealand bound under Westminster Parliament via the Constitution Act 1852 and the Statute of Westminster Adoption Act 1947 shall, in pursuance of the Declaration of Independence, the Treaty of Waitangi, the Te Ture Whenua Māori Act, Māori Land Act 1993, sections 2(3), 5, 253 and 253A and 268(3) give full obedience to directives of the Native peoples and Māori peoples of Ahi Kaa and their Haapu and Whanau to make amendments to any and all Statutes and other matters which stands, effective both nationally and internationally.
