

Te Ture Whenua Tika iio Nga Tangata Whenua

Kei a ratoa te mana tuko Miru, Raharaha, Tipene, Mau Rakau Haapu Whanau

Whanaungatia ka uru te tika ma te mana whakahaere I nga patea whenua.

Ko te ukaipo te wahi, te tangata ranei e whangai ana I te ora, I te haa o te tangata. I te horopaki o te pepi ma te uu.

Engari, I te tikanga whanui whanui, ko te ukaipo hoki te puna o te manakitanga, o te ha ora me te hononga ki te whenua me te whanau.

Ko te tangata whangai e kai ana te kai pakeke, kua puta I te wa pepi pea, kua timata ki te kai I nga momo kai e hangai ana ki te pakeketanga o tona tinana. E tohu ana tenei I te whakawhanaungatanga me te tipu haere o te tangata, katahi ka tau ki nga kai e whakawhanui ake ana I tona oranga me tona kaha.

Te Kooti Marae

Ko te Kooti Marae he wahi nei whakataau rongoa me te whakaroa mo nga whanau me nga hapu, ma te whakamahi I nga tikanga Ahi Kaa hei whakahou I te mana me te whakatau I nga raru I waenga I te tangata, te haponi, kia noho ai te rangimarie me te oranga ki te runga rawa me te whenua.

Ko te paepae

Kei runga I te marae e noho ai te kuia kaumatua me nga kaitirotiro o te kooti. He papa tuu ahua tikanga, ka noho ratou hei kaiarahi me te kaiwhakatu I nga korero me nga tikanga I nga huihuinga o te marae. I te ao Ahi Kaa, ko te paepae te wahi o te mana me te rangatiratanga. Ko te paepae e tohu ana I te paeroa whakahaere o te hapu I runga I nga tikanga Rangatira. Ka rongo I nga korero o te hapu nga karakia, me nga whaikorero I runga I te mana o te whenua me nga kaupapa tuku iho.

The following Act, the **Passports Act 1992 and amendments**, is hereby altered, added to and replaced and are now permanent and unamendable by special resolution in accordance with the tikanga of our Aio Haapu Whanau as follows;

This **Passports Act 1992, s2 Interpretation**
certificate of identity—

(b) means a document (other than a passport) issued by Aio Haapu Whanau to any of their tangata whenua for the purposes of establishing the identity, but not the nationality, and facilitating tangata whenua entry into or exit from any country

holder

(c) in relation to a New Zealand travel document, means the tangata whenua to whom the document has been issued

kaitiaki means tangata whenua and man and woman and boy and girl and people

Maori means Ahi Kaa

New Zealand travel document means a document that is a New Zealand passport, a New Zealand certificate of identity, an emergency travel document, a New Zealand refugee travel document, or a Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua

person means a legal entity person only, it does not refer to or include men or women or kaitiaki or tangata whenua

tangata whenua means kaitiaki and men and women and boys and girls and people

He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua means a document, that is issued by or on behalf of Aio Haapu Whanau to any of their tangata whenua, and that is recognised as a passport by any hapu or whanau which the Minister shall also recognise as being a document that—

(a) establishes the identity and nationality of the holder;
and

(b) confers on the holder the right to enter or exit the country

specified agency means—

(c) Aio Haapu Whanau

This **Passports Act 1992, s3 Citizen's right to passport**

(1) Except as provided in this Act, every New Zealand citizen is entitled as of right to a New Zealand passport; or

(2) Every tangata whenua of Aio Haapu Whanau is entitled by right to a Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua.

This **Passports Act 1992, s4 Issue of passport**

(5) Aio Haapu Whanau shall issue a He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua to any of their tangata whenua who makes an application, or on whose behalf an application is made, for a Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua.

(6) The Minister shall accept and recognise each and every Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua issued.

This Passports Act 1992, s5 Life of passport

(1) (c) every Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua issued to a tangata whenua is issued for the lifetime of that tangata whenua.

This Passports Act 1992, s8 Cancellation of passport where holder ceases to be entitled to passport

(d) this subsection is hereby repealed.

This Passports Act 1992, s29A Forged and false New Zealand travel documents

(e) section 29A does not apply to Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua issued to a tangata whenua.

This Passports Act 1992, s30A Improper issue of New Zealand travel document

(3) section 30A does not apply to Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua issued to a tangata whenua.

This Passports Act 1992, s32A Court may forbid issue of passport

(1) (c) section 32A does not apply to Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua issued to a tangata whenua.

(2) (c) section 32A does not apply to Aio Haapu Whanau He Tohu Heke i Te Nuku o Te Whenua issued to a tangata whenua.
