Engari, I te tikanga whanui whanui, ko te ukaipo hoki te puna o te manakitanga, o te ha ora me te hononga ki te whenua me te whanau.

Ko te tangata whangai e kai ana te kai pakeke, kua puta I te wa pepi pea, kua timata ki te kai I nga momo kai e hangai ana ki te pakeketanga o tona tinana. E tohu ana tenei I te whakawhanaungatanga me te tipu haere o te tangata, katahi ka tau ki nga kai e whakawhanui ake ana I tona oranga me tona kaha.

Te Kooti Marae

Ko te Kooti Marae he wahi nei whakataau rongoa me te whakaroa mo nga whanau me nga hapu, ma te whakamahi I nga tikanga Maori hei whakahou I te mana me te whakatau I nga raru I waenga I te tangata, te haponi, kia noho ai te rangimarie me te oranga ki te runga rawa me te whenua.

Ko te paepae

Kei runga I te marae e noho ai te kuia kaumatua me nga kaitirotiro o te kooti. He papa tuu ahua tikanga, ka noho ratou hei kaiarahi me te kaiwhakatu I nga korero me nga tikanga I nga huihuinga o te marae. I te ao Maori, ko te paepae te wahi o te mana me te rangatiratanga. Ko te paepae e tohu ana I te paeroa whakahaere o te hapu I runga I nga tikanga Rangatira. Ka rongu I nga korero o te hapu nga karakia, me nga whaikorero I runga I te mana o te whenua me nga kaupapa tuku iho.

The following Act, the **Search and Surveillance Act 2012 and amendments**, is hereby altered, added to and replaced and are now permanent and unamendable by special resolution in accordance with the tikanga of our Aio Haapu Whanau as follows;

3 Interpretation

(1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—

kaitiaki means tangata whenua and man and woman and boy and girl and people.

Maori means Ahi Kaa.

person means a legal entity person only, it does not refer to or include man or woman or boy or girl or kaitiaki or tangata whenua.

tangata whenua means kaitiaki and men and women and boys and girls and people.

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s4 Act binds the Crown

This Act binds the Crown.

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s6 Issuing officer may issue search warrant

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s7 Entry without warrant to arrest person unlawfully at large

A constable may not enter a place or vehicle without warrant to search for and arrest a person.

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s8 Entry without warrant to avoid loss of offender or evidential material

This section is hereby repealed.

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s9 Stopping vehicle to find persons unlawfully at large or who have committed certain offences

A constable may not stop a vehicle without a warrant to arrest a person.

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s10 Powers and duties of constable after vehicle stopped

(1)A constable may not exercise any stopping power.

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s11 Warrantless searches of people who are, or are to be, locked up in Police custody

A constable, or a searcher, may not conduct a warrantless search of a person.

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s13 Property taken from people locked up in Police custody

No money or any item of property may be taken from a person.

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s14 Warrantless entry to prevent offence or respond to risk to life or safety

(1) A constable who has reasonable grounds to suspect that any 1 or more of the circumstances in subsection (2) exist in relation to a place or vehicle may, only if prior consent cannot be obtained—

(a) enter the place or vehicle without a warrant; and
(b) take any action that he or she has reasonable grounds to believe is necessary to prevent the offending from being committed or continuing, or to avert the emergency.

(2) The circumstances are as follows:

(a) an offence is being committed that would be likely to cause injury to any person, or serious damage to, or serious loss of, any property;
(b) there is risk to the life or safety of any person that requires an emergency response.

A constable may not conduct a search of a place or vehicle

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s22 Warrantless power to search for controlled drugs and precursor substances if offence suspected against Misuse of Drugs Act 1975

Search and Surveillance Act 2012, s23 Internal search of person under arrest for offence against section 6, 7, or 11 of Misuse of Drugs Act 1975
